

A glimpse of Mandarin

MANDARIN Stone has imported natural stone since 1990. Its longstanding relationships with suppliers and experience of market trends place it in an excellent position to offer hundreds of high quality choices, from tiles in limestone and granite to terracotta and schist.

Mandarin Stone's decorative Renaissance range has been created using the ancient technique of etching. Using totally hand-made templates, the acid-etching process, often combined with silver gilt, is impressed onto limestone and marble, creating a precious and refined base-relief design. Base tiles are also available to complement the decorative tiles.

The limestone offering is perhaps Mandarin Stone's most comprehensive. Jerusalem Ancien Provence is a new stone and finish in Mandarin's range. It consists of a mélange of the various Jerusalem stones that are then subject to many

processes and hand-finished to give each piece of stone a unique worn look.

It is available in a large random pattern which adds authenticity to its reclaimed look. Mandarin Stone also offers the Bourgogne Clair and Jaune limestone – more neutral in shade in the new Provence finish.

Mandarin Stone's headquarters is in Monmouth, but the company has showrooms in Bath, Cardiff, Cheltenham, Exeter and Bergerac, with two opening this year, in Bristol and Marlow.
